## ISNA CANADA'S HALAL PROCEDURE FOR CERTIFICATION

### 1. Complete the Application:

Submit the Application for Halal Certification to ISNA Canada by fax or e-mail.

### 2. Audit / Inspection:

After reviewing the application, a set up date to conduct inspection to determine the compliance of the ingredients, and sanitation procedures in accordance with halal requirements is scheduled. A complete report would be submitted to ISNA Canada to process the halal application.

### 3. Ingredients Information:

A complete specification sheet for all critical ingredients along with labels information must be submitted for review and approved by ISNA Canada.

### 4. Certification / Supervision Fees:

The certification fee is set on a yearly basis, and the nature of the business would determine the fees to be charged and the complexity of the products to be reviewed, number of plants, total volume of products, and consultation / supervision during the year.

### 5. Confidential Agreement Signed:

A confidential agreement is executed, terms and conditions explained for the term of the contract for the period of one year.

### 6. Halal Certification Issued:

Halal Certificate is issued after the payment is received and the company would be allowed to use ISNA-Canada Halal Certification Agency logo on its product.

### 7. Final Steps:

ISNA Halal Certification Agency will guide you to make your products successful.
